(Boston) Celebrity Series of Boston will present <u>pianist Rafał Blechacz</u> on Wednesday, April 11, 2018, at 8pm at Longy's Edward M. Pickman Hall, Longy School of Music of Bard College, 27 Garden Street, Cambridge, MA. The Debut Series is generously sponsored by Harriet and David Griesinger and the Longy School of Music of Bard College. This concert marks the Celebrity Series debut performance for Rafał Blechacz.

This performance is sold out.

Pianist **Rafał Blechacz** has won numerous awards, including all five first prizes at the 15th International Chopin Piano Competition in Warsaw in 2005, the first pianist to achieve this feat. Professor Piotr Paleczny, one of the competition's judges, said that Blechacz "so outclassed the remaining finalists that no second prize could actually be awarded." He has also won the 2002 Arthur Rubenstein in Memoriam piano competition in Bydogszcz, the 2003 Hamamatsu International Piano Competition, and the 2004 International Piano Competition in Morocco. On February 24, 2015, during a performance by the Warsaw Philharmonic, Blechacz received the President of the Republic of Poland's medal Cavalier's Cross of the Order of Polonia. He was also named the 2014 Gilmore Artist, only the seventh individual to receive this award.

Blechacz has performed as a solo recitalist and with symphony orchestras throughout Europe, America, and Asia, in some of the world's most prestigious concert halls, such as the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, Musikverein in Vienna, Berliner Philharmonie, Alte Oper in Frankfurt, Herkulessaal in Munich, Salle Pleyel in Paris, the Royal Festival Hall as well as the Wigmore Hall in London, Tonhalle in Zurich, and La Scala in Milan. He has performed with Radio-Symphonieorchester Wien and Minnesota Orchestra, been on tour with Camerata Salzburg and Kammerorchester Basel under the baton of Trevor Pinnock, and gave recitals in Berlin's Philharmonie, Prinzregententheater Munich, Cité de la musique Paris, Tisch Center New York, among others.

Highlights of his 2017/2018 season include a tour in Germany and the UK with the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra and Mirga Gražinytė-Tyla as well as recitals in Japan, Korea, and Taiwan in autumn, then in New York, Boston, Atlanta, and Vancouver in the spring.

Blechacz is an exclusive recording artist of Deutsche Grammophon. His debut CD of Chopin Preludes won the Platinum Record status in his native Poland, as well as a German Echo Klassik and French

Diapason d'Or award. His CD of both Chopin concerti with the Concertgebouw Orchestra under the baton of Jerzy Semkow was awarded the Preis der Deutschen Schallplattenkritik. In 2012, his recording of works by Debussy and Szymanowski was released and awarded Recording of the Month by *Gramophone* magazine and Solo Recording of the Year by Echo Klassik. These are followed by the acclaimed release of his fifth album of Chopin Polonaises in 2013, and the most recent solo CD of works by J.S Bach in 2017.

Born in 1985 in Nakło nad Notecią, Blechacz started playing piano at the age of five. He studied in the Artur Rubinstein State Primary School of Music in Bydgoszcz under the supervision of Professor Jacek Polański. In 2007, he graduated from the Academy of Music in Bydgoszcz, studying under Katarzyna Popowa-Zydroń. Taking a sabbatical from the stage in 2016, Blechacz completed his Ph.D. thesis in philosophy of music.
