Getting There

To get to Jazz Along the Charles, you will cross a bridge over a busy road. There might be a lot of people on the bridge, especially right before the **2:00 PM** start time.

Information Tents

When you arrive at the park, a person in a blue Jazz Along the Charles t-shirt might welcome you, and there will be an information tent with more helpers in blue shirts. You can ask them anything about the event.

Listening to Bands

You will see bands under white tents all around the park. There are 25 bands, and they will all play the same songs at the same time. You can choose where you go, and what bands you want to hear.

If you like a band, you can listen to them for as long as you want to. If you don't like a band, or just want to move along, you can move on to the next tent. The concert ends at **4:00 PM** but you can leave whenever you want to.







Taking a Break

If you need to sit down, there are benches around the park.

There will be food trucks and a water truck near the center of the event.

There will be an enclosed tent with farm tables (long tables with benches), smaller tables, and chairs near the food trucks.

There is a playground in the park, near the Hatch Shell lawn, with climbing structures and a zip line.

Restrooms

You can find indoor bathrooms at the Community Boating Boathouse, and in a building behind the Hatch Shell.

There will be portable toilets near the center of the event and near the Dartmouth Street Footbridge.
